Harvey J. Byram (former principal 1980-1987) passed away on February 8, 2020. During his tenure, in 1981, the central and south wings of the classroom building were completed, connecting the administration building to the gym. The cafeteria-music building was also added in 1986 under his leadership. He raised the funds to construct these buildings and also increased the varsity sports program at HVA. The 1983 yearbook was dedicated to him.

Betty Martin-McPeck (Former Faculty 1963-1967) passed away on January 27, 2020. She was a former music teacher who was loved by many from Mt. Aetna Academy.

Gene Hobbs (Former Faculty 1986-2003) passed away in December 2019. He worked on many different things but was known for Grounds and Transportation for the school.

J. Edward Turner (Former Faculty 1967-1968) passed away on January 31, 2019. He was the boy's dean when he was here. His wife, Ruth, remembers that the year was memorable, full of challenges and great learning difficulties. Ed dedicated his life to Christian education and Highland View Academy was where his career began.




